



## Technical Action Plan:

### Outputs from the PMSE Forum: Spectrum for Wireless Cameras - Friday 25 May 2007

#### Introduction

On Friday 25 May 2007 JFMG held, at the request of the industry, a forum on Spectrum for Wireless Cameras. The forum provided an environment for both users and manufacturers to share their thoughts and ideas on the imminent changes to their spectrum provision, as well as on a number of existing operational difficulties.
