Guidance Notes for Frequency Assignment Application for Point to Point Sound links

Please supply the fullest possible information in order that we may give you the most appropriate frequency assignments. The details which we require are:

Licensee: This should be the name of the organisation or person who will be using the equipment

Contact name and numbers: In case we have any queries about your request. The confirmation of assignment will be sent to this person, normally by fax, post or email.

Operational Phone: a number we can use to contact the operator whenever the equipment is in use. A mobile number is acceptable for this purpose.

Programme or Event: Please describe briefly the purpose for which the link will be used.

Dates and Times: The start and finish times of the operation. If it lasts for more than one day, state the operational times for each day. (Transmitters should not normally be left running if not in use and unattended). All transmissions MUST be included, including equipment setup and testing. Annual licences are issued from midnight to midnight.

Transmitter Information & Receiver Information: This information is needed so that we can check whether your link will interfere with existing links, or will suffer interference from them. If you do not have the equipment details, please consult your supplier.

Location: Please include the National Grid Reference and full postal address including Post Code.

Frequency: Please state the frequency required. We will always try to assign your preferred frequencies, but if they are not available we will have to suggest others. We will specify the polarisation to be used as part of your licence details.

Notice: Please give us as much notice as possible of your requirement, particularly if you need airborne clearance or if there are other special factors. If you need more space for details, please use an additional sheet. All requests must be signed and dated.

PAYMENT OF FEES:- Please ensure that the correct fee is included. If you are not sure of the right amount, call us for advice. Fees should be paid by sending a cheque with the application form, payable to the **JFMG Limited (Trust Account)**; cash, bank transfer, or bank draft in pounds sterling. We also accept debit cards or Visa / Access / Mastercard / American Express credit cards. Please indicate if you have carnets.
